Drop Visor Instructions



Steps:

- 1) Visor bracket channels are attached to visor body @ Factory.
- 2) Remove your current visor:

Note: You will need to reuse the bolts which go into the side of the cab at the ends of the visor.


- 3) Grind off the heads of the Huck bolts.
 - a) Hold the existing brackets in place and take your time grinding Huck heads. If you grind too fast or hard it will melt the paint around the head. It is recommended that you only grind a little bit at a time.
- 4) Carefully pull down headliner toward front of cab (interior support plates will mount inside of cab).
- 5) Bolt Visor Halves together with center brackets sandwiched in between.
 - Attach Visor brackets to visor body including 2 piece small brackets.
- 6) Install the visor on the truck ends first.
 - a. Screw in a couple of turns the "side of cab bolts" through the holes in the end of the visor. Use lock washers on bolts at visor end that mount directly to truck cab to prevent loosening due to normal road vibrations.
- Hold visor up to truck to align brkts & mark holes to drill (requires 2 persons).
- 8) Drill holes in cab (using 1/4" drill bit). Interior support plates mount inside of truck.
- 9) Insert bolts (see reverse). Once you feel the bolt "bottom out" STOP TIGHTENING. Use support plates inside of cab. Note: use rubber washers between outer cab bracket and truck cab to prevent damaging cab.
- Align visor as desired and tighten all bolts.
- 11) Remove the PVC coating from the visor.
- 12) Wipe away fingerprints with window cleaner.
